

MISSION

ED-REAP Excellence Award

PROGRAM:

ED-REAP, in compliance with its vision, mission, and objectives, has established **The ED-REAP Excellence Award Program** to recognize highly qualified student(s) graduating from undergraduate degree programs of Ethiopian Universities and Colleges.

The program recognizes highly qualified student(s) graduating from the undergraduate programs of selected Ethiopian universities each year (with a goal of including all Ethiopian universities as more financial resources become available).

Two awards will be given annually from each university and the key objective criteria for assessing sustained excellence and being selected as winner will be cumulative GPA (CGPA).

PURPOSE:

The main purpose of the Excellence Award is to inspire students to excel in their academic endeavor by providing recognition to highly qualified students graduating from the undergraduate programs who are currently enrolled in various departments of public Universities in Ethiopia.

ELIGIBILITY:

- To be eligible for the Excellence Award, a student must be a graduating senior (i.e. enrolled in the final year second semester) with **the highest final CGPA** across all faculties and schools.
- Two awardees, a male and a female, will be selected from each university based on CGPA.

ED-REAP Excellence Award

PROCEDURES/STEPS FOR SELECTION:

- The university will announce a call for the award.
- The candidates will submit a motivation letter annexed with documents explaining why he/she should win the award besides to their CGPA.
- The dean of each college will identify the eligible students with the highest CGPA to Academic Vice president of each university.
- University Management will identify the students according to the eligibility criteria shown above, and forward the list (along with student transcripts) to ED-REAP president.
- After reviewing the nominations, ED-REAP Leadership will decide on the awardee(s).
- ED-REAP President will notify University Management of the awardee(s).
- University Management will send an Excellence Award Notification to the awardee(s).

AWARD FEATURES:

- The Award consists of Certificate of ED-REAP Excellence Award, and a maximum monetary prize of Birr 3,000 for each awardee.
- In the event that there are ties or more than one eligible candidate, the eligibility will consider the following criteria to identify the winner:
- Extra-curricular activity engagement (25% for non-political club membership, 25% for executive and coordinator level participation in non-political clubs and institutions, 50% for free community service which includes service as student union, free service in library, forestation, discipline, mentoring fellow students, tutorial service to high school students, and other related engagements. These have to be supported by official letters.
- The Excellence award should be given in a colorful manner by preparing a ceremonial program. (Graduation day can be one choice).

ED-REAP Excellence Award

OBLIGATIONS & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Each University is responsible for a 100% payment (i.e. without any overhead deduction) to the awardee(s).
- If the recipient fails to collect his/her award within 6 months, his/her award will be revoked.
 And the money returned to a designated ED-REAP account.
